## The Power of a Whisper—Right Now Media

Mark Batterson said we often have "ears that have been deafened to the voice of God."

Sometimes we believe lies from the enemy that muffle God's voice.

In Genesis 1:1-5 the Bible tells us that God created the earth with just his voice.

Mark listed several times in Scripture when God speaks and mighty things happen.

He called Abraham, He talked to Moses through the burning bush, He spoke through dreams to His prophets.

For Abraham, God shows His power to lead His people. For Moses, it reveals God's power in calling people into His mission. For the prophets, it shows God's power to know the future and equip His people for it.

God speaks to us all the time in various ways, but we don't always listen.

In 1Samuel 3:1-10, when Samuel hears God speaking to him he thought it was Eli.

Mark talked about how Samuel did not yet know the Lord, which is why he mistook God's voice for Eli's.

Why does God sometimes speak in a whisper?

Mark said that you have to get close to someone to hear them whisper. More than hearing God, the goal is intimacy with Him.

God loves us and desires a relationship with us. That's why He speaks to us. We're going to explore how He speaks in this series. 
