In Abilene, James was hired to teach at Bowie Elementary School. I did not have a job.



James and Ashley, our ninth grade daughter, came to Abilene to start school while I remained in Akron to pack everything and meet the movers.

When I finally arrived in Abilene, I unpacked and tried to become familiar with the city. Then I signed up to substitute, which I enjoyed. Next, I decided to teach again. I started at Jefferson Middle School. James and I were both happy, but Ashley did have a difficult adjustment at Cooper High School.

We bought a house and started to look for a church. In Akron, we attended a very large church, and both of us sang in the choir. There were no churches in Abilene that were as large as the one we attended in Akron. As we had grownup as Southern Baptist, we started visiting the larger Baptist churches in Abilene. We did not feel as though any church we visited was where God wanted us to attend.

One Sunday, as James was reading the newspaper, he told me about a Methodist church that needed a music director. We talked it over and decided it would be a good place to attend. James applied and was hired.

There was an active youth group for Ashley, and the church was so friendly. We felt at home the very first time we attended.

And thus, we became members of Elmwood West Methodist Church. James was an active member and involved in the choir and music of the church until his death. I was involved in choir and worship committee for many years. For 35 years this church has been a very essential part of our lives.

The balance in the account to make these payments is \$11,781


This gives us a surplus of almost one year of payments.


